

CNCP is Committed to Community Service

In the past two years, CNCP's students have demonstrated their commitment to serving the community, not only by promoting health and wellness through education and awareness but also through their contributions of time, money, food, and blood. CNCP's students, faculty, staff, and pharmacy preceptors have participated in 71 community service events, including collaborations with the American Heart Association, the local pharmacy associations (SVPHA, CPHA, and CSHP), Blood Source, Poison Control, the Pharmacy Foundation and other Colleges of pharmacy. The health education, awareness and prevention events consisted of educational seminars/workshops and information tables about Medication Safety, Hypertension, Stroke, Sexually Transmitted Infections (STIs), osteoporosis, smoking cessation, seasonal allergies, and HPV risk for cervical cancer.
